A Habilitation Specialist will be responsible for the following duties: Carrying out individual youth programs ensuring that youth are engaged in programs and activities which support the goals of the youths Individual Support and Service Plan, actively participating with youth in all scheduled activities, consistently assisting youth in the area of self-help skills, (eating, dressing, toileting, feeding communication etc.), accompanying youth on off campus field trips, engaging youth in activities as defined/listed in the youth's activity schedule, document necessary and/or requested information on a daily basis, follow safe lifting practices in lifting and moving youth who are in a wheelchair or who need special assistance.

To qualify for this position, you must be at least 21 years of age, with a high school diploma or equivalency, possess a valid IL driver's license, and the ability to qualify as a DCFS driver. Previous CNA experience a PLUS but not required. Qualified candidates will be required to complete a reading comprehension test, drug screen and criminal background check.
