



Crisis Prevention Board Certified Behavior Analyst

The Hope Institute for Children and Families is seeking four Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA) to serve as members of the Crisis to Prevention-Support Services Team responsible for behavioral assessments, functional analyses, behavior program design and development (based upon ABA principles), data tracking and analyses, and ongoing monitoring or efficacy of the program plan. The BCBA also provides crisis services for individuals at risk of being displaced from their current placement, ensures family and/or support staff are appropriately trained and have the tools needed to effectively implement the behavior support plan for the individual.

Requirements include a Master's Degree, with major coursework in behavior analysis and modification from a graduate program accredited by the Association for Behavior Analysis, successful completion of and a license as a BCBA. Must complete a background clearance, physical and drug/alcohol screen.
